Location sites include soup kitchens, food pantries, City Harvest Mobile Markets, City Harvest Community Partner Mobile Markets, Department of Education School Sites that are distributing grab-and-go meals, some restaurants that are offering free food distribution, and City Harvest Emergency Relief Sites. Hours of operation vary by site and will be updated as info is provided.

	Open Soup Kitchens and Food Pantries	Places to go to get free food. Hours of operation vary.
	Closed Soup Kitchens and Food Pantries	Places that normally give free food but are closed at the moment (this is constantly changing).
	Emergency Relief Sites	“Pop-Up” or Temporary Sites Providing Free Food Distribution
	DOE School Feeding Sites (Meal Hubs)	The New York City Department of Education is giving away three free meals available daily for any New Yorker. Meals can be picked up at all Meal Hubs 7:30 am to 1:30 pm, Monday through Friday. Meals Hubs will operate for children and families from 7:30 am to 11:30 am, and for adults from 11:30 am to 1:30 pm.
	NYC Restaurants	Restaurants in NYC currently offering free food programs.
	Mobile Markets	Open-Air Produce Distribution run by City Harvest. Free produce to all who attend. Hours/days vary by site.
	Community Partner Mobile Markets	Open-Air Produce Distribution run by City Harvest Partners. Free produce to all who attend. Hours/days vary by site.
